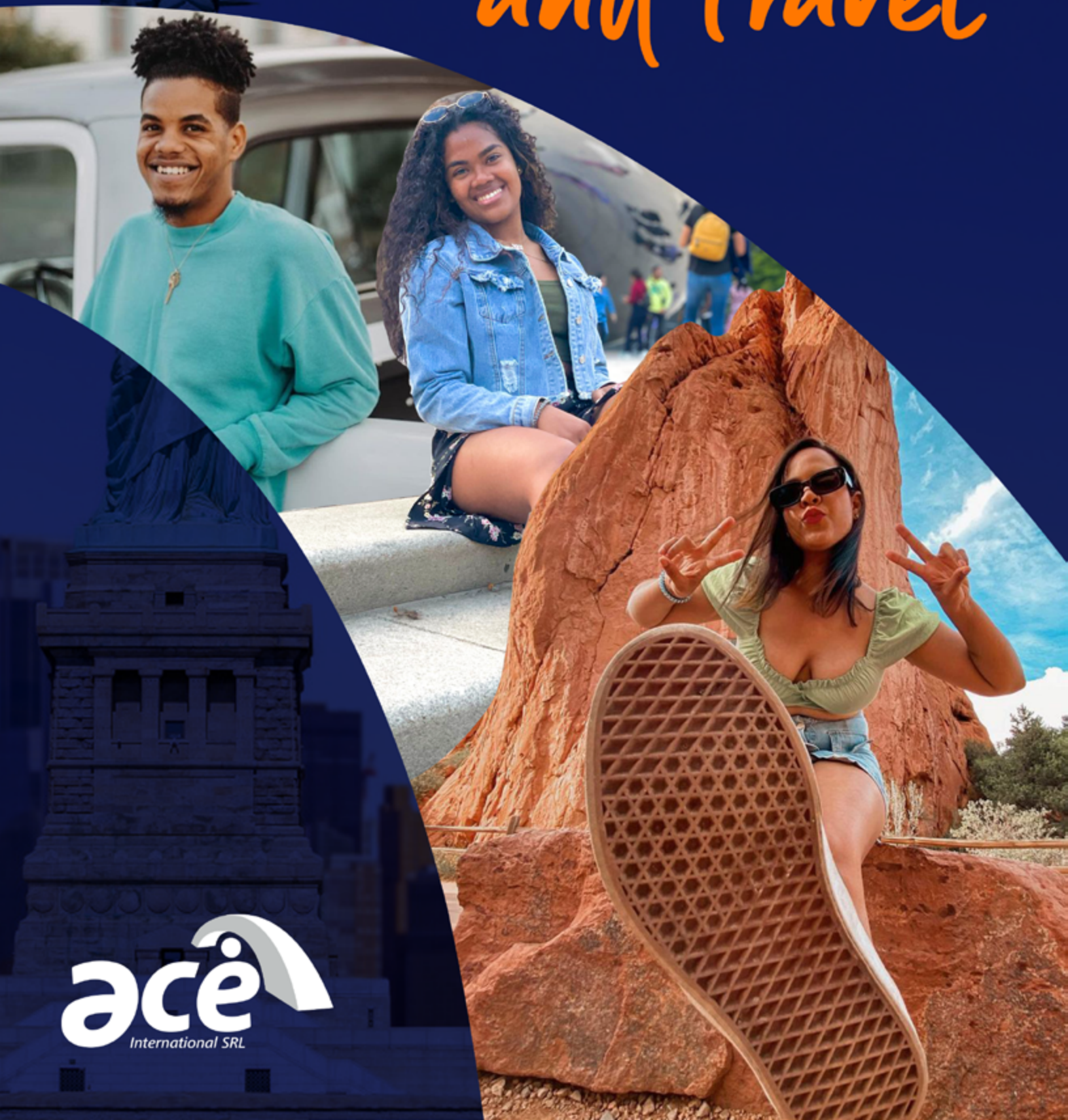


Summer Work *and Travel*

DETAILED PROGRAM INFORMATION

WHAT IS THE SUMMER WORK AND TRAVEL PROGRAM?

It is a program that is specifically designed for young university students who are enrolled full time. The main objective is to provide them with the opportunity to travel to the United States, share cultures and immerse themselves in the American way of life. In addition, we offer them the possibility of working legally and enjoying their temporary stay in the United States.



WHAT IS THE ORIGIN OF THE PROGRAM?

The program was created by the United States Department of State with the aim of bringing different cultures closer together.

WHAT ARE THE OBJECTIVES OF THIS PROGRAM?

- 1 Interact with North American culture and other countries.
- 2 Acquire work experience legally in various types of workplaces.
- 3 Improve knowledge of the English language through practice.
- 4 Learn to manage with the income received, which allows them to support their expenses in the United States during their stay.
- 5 Develop their independence and maturity.





WHAT IS THE DURATION OF THE PROGRAM?

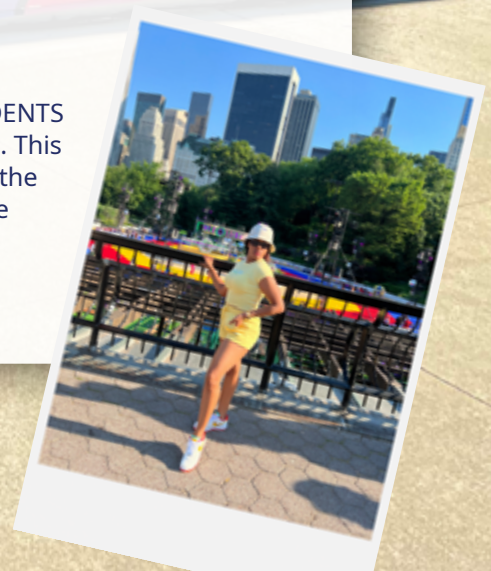
Departures to the United States are scheduled throughout the month of May, in accordance with the start dates of the work contract. The minimum duration of the program is 3 months, while the maximum duration is 4 months of work, with an additional period of up to one month to enjoy your vacation. It is important to bear in mind that this rest period should not interfere with the start of your classes for the September-December semester.

WHAT TYPE OF VISA IS NEEDED FOR THIS PROGRAM?

This program uses the J-1 visa exchange. The United States government issues the J-1 visa to young people who participate in a wide variety of exchange programs sponsored by schools, businesses, and various organizations and institutions. It is important to note that the J-1 visa is different from the tourist or pleasure visa known as the B1/B2 visa. Therefore, students holding a B1/B2 visa will need to obtain a J-1 visa in order to participate.

NOTE: When the consulate issues the J-1 visa, IN THE CASE OF STUDENTS WITH B1/B2 VISA, THEIR TOURIST OR B1/B2 VISA IS NOT AFFECTED. This means that your tourist visa remains intact, since entry and exit to the United States will be carried out with the J-1 visa issued through the program.





WHICH ARE THE SALARIES TO RECEIVE?

Salaries vary depending on various factors, such as the type of job, position, company offerings, and geographic location. The

students receive salaries similar to those of other young Americans who work during the summer. These

WHICH ARE THE TYPES OF JOBS WHAT ARE OFFERED?

Ace International has a wide range of job opportunities available. Our employers visit the Republic Dominican for the purpose of getting to know our students, who are hired for work in various positions, such as F&B (food service, waiter, busboy, bartender, etc.), reception, cashier, sales assistant, housekeepers, cooks attendants, line cooks, park attendant, activity Host, among many others.



WHAT ARE THE PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS?

- 1 Be an ACTIVE university student (both at the time of applying and for the period preceding the start date of the trip).
- 2 Be between 17 and 26 years of age.
- 3 Possess basic knowledge of the ENGLISH LANGUAGE.
- 4 Not be in the process of North American Residence.
Being a responsible, mature and independent person is essential to participate in our program.
- 5 In addition, it is important to highlight that flexibility is required, since you must be willing to be assigned in any state within the United States.

We urge anyone interested in participating in the Summer Work and Travel Bridge USA program to be aware that this program is not designed to save large sums of money. Instead, it focuses on providing an enriching experience culturally, linguistically, and at work. It is important that participants understand that they will need to be financially self-sufficient during their stay.

WHEN SHOULD I APPLY?

Our company offers applications throughout the year, which means that students can apply at any time. This gives students a margin of time to complete the paperwork.

WHAT IS THE COST OF THE PROGRAM AND WHAT IS INCLUDED IN THE BASIC INVESTMENT?

The cost of the program amounts to two thousand three hundred fifty-five dollars **USD\$2,355.00** and includes the following:

- Employment management through our Sponsors.
- The issuance of the DS-2019 (Legal work permit with the prior approval of the Department of State.
- Health insurance.
- SEVIS.
- Advice from the ACE Staff during consular processes.
- Program T-shirt.
- Ace Files (exclusive program folder).
- Orientation talk, prior to your departure to the United States of America.
- Assistance from our Sponsor office in the United States, orientation / Pre-departure talk, assistance and advice from OUR TEAM. These assistances are offered in our orientation meetings / talks and permanently with our office staff.
