## WHAT ARE THE PROGRAM BENEFITS?


- 1. Cultural Exchange: A chance to explore new cultures, traditions, beliefs, societies, languages, and more. These opportunities allow participants to see the world through a different lens.
- 2. Personal Growth: By experiencing different cultures, you will gain a better understanding of your own and develop awareness of the traditions that shape our society. This self-awareness will contribute to both personal and professional growth.
- **3. Independence:** This experience will help you become more self-sufficient. As you face the challenges of being away from home—often for the first time—you'll learn to manage your own needs independently of your family.
- **4. Practice English:** You'll be immersed in an English-speaking environment, allowing you to improve your English fluency (if you're not a native speaker) while teaching others words and phrases from your own language.
- **5. Camp Salary:** To help cover the cost of the program, you'll receive a stipend (commonly referred to as "pocket money") to offset your expenses and possibly save a bit for post-camp travel.
- **6. Work Experience:** In addition to all the amazing benefits, you'll gain valuable skills that will help you in your career—public speaking, teamwork, problem-solving, supervision, leadership, and more.

Note: Earning a large income is not the program's goal.

# WHO IS THE IDEAL CANDIDATE FOR AN INTERNATIONAL CAMP?

- 1 Aged 18 to 28
- Intermediate English
- 3 Ability to supervise and interact with American youth
- A post-secondary student, youth worker, teacher, or individual with specialized skills (team sports, water sports, arts and crafts, etc.)
- 5 Enthusiastic and passionate about learning new customs and cultures
- 6 No criminal record and able to provide a local background check

In general, all applicants should be enthusiastic, energetic, and love working with children.



## WHAT TYPES OF CAMPS ARE THERE?

Camps are located across the United States in both rural and urban areas. They can be day camps or overnight camps and offer a variety of experiences. Common types include:

- Private Camps: Privately owned and operated.
- Non-profit Camps: Operated by charitable organizations.
- Specialty Camps: Focused on a specific activity or skill.
- Special Needs Camps: For children and adults with disabilities.
- Themed Camps: Focused on specific sports or activities.
- Day Camps: Only operate during the day; campers go home at night.
- **Religious Camps:** With a religious emphasis (mainly Christian and Jewish).




## WHAT SKILLS ARE REQUIRED?

The cost of the program is \$825.00 US dollars.

#### **Includes:**

- Consular appointment fee (approx. \$187 USD, paid via Banco Popular)
- Additional expenses: approx. \$100-\$500 USD
- Optional grace period insurance: \$50 USD
- Airfare
