
What is the Teach USA?

The Teach USA program connects highly qualified and enthusiastic international teachers with host schools in the United States, fostering cultural understanding. The goal of the Teach USA program is to promote interaction and enhance mutual understanding between U.S. and international teachers.

Teaching Opportunities:

Participants are placed in host schools **for one year**, teaching various subjects such as:

- Education, Social Sciences, Library.
- Science, Counseling and Social Services.
- Media and Communications.
- Management, Business, Commerce and Finance.
- Science, Engineering, Architecture.
- Mathematics and Industrial Occupations.

- Be a graduate student of Education with at least one year of experience in the area (if graduated more than one year ago).
- Be a second year student in the Education program.



Program cost

The cost of the program is **USD \$4,957.00** and includes:

- Labor Permit (DS-2019).
- Sevis fee (required for visa type).
- Consular assistance and orientation.
- Personalized orientation before and during the program.
- Online portal of resources and applications.
- Medical insurance.
- Accommodation management support.

It does NOT include:

- Air ticket.
- Purchase of the Consular Appointment at BANCO POPULAR of USD \$187.00 (the total amount varies according to the rate established by the embassy).
- Transportation expenses to the consulate on the day of your consular appointment (in the case of the Northern Zone).
- Lodging, food and transportation expenses during the first two weeks of your arrival in the United States.

Note: Please budget approximately US\$ 300-700 for additional expenses. Other additional expenses may be incurred by the Dominican Government (airport taxes) or the U.S. Government (airport or security taxes) or the Consulate.



WHEN TO APPLY?

Our company works throughout the year, so those interested have the opportunity to apply at any date. Trips are scheduled to take place between July and August of the year of participation.

WHAT YOU NEED TO APPLY

To apply to the program, you must have a first interview where we will evaluate your profile. For this interview, you will need:

- Copy of your identity card.
- Copy of your passport (if you have one).
- Copy of your class schedule or copy of your diploma in case you have graduated.
- Payment of the fee for the interview: RD\$2,500.00.
